Call for Church Officer Nominations

First Pres members are invited to assist the Nominating Committee in identifying those members who are willing to serve as Elders, Deacons and Trustees. All nominees must be church members, faithful in following Christ, and possessing leadership abilities. Descriptions of each office are given to assist you. Write the person’s name on this form and drop it in the offering plate or at the church reception desk.

DEACON: Following Christ’s example, deacons serve with a loving heart and sound judgment. Their ministry is funded through communion offerings. Two regular places of service are the Sunday coffee hour and the Clothes Closet for the needy. They provide homebound communion, visits to shut-ins, and seasonal projects such as the backpack projects and Angel Tree.

ELDER: Elders are commissioned to provide leadership in discipleship, governance, and discipline. Elders, individually and with the Session strengthen and nurture the faith of the congregation, encourage people in worship, equip them for service in the church and in the world.

TRUSTEE: Trustees provide leadership in stewardship and financial management. The Trustees have the power to receive, hold, encumber, manage, and transfer the property and financial resources of the church to further its purposes.
